OPENING- The meeting was called to order by Mayor Smedley at 7:00 pm. Smedley asked the Council to review their copies of the January 10, 2019 meeting minutes and today's agenda. Mayor asked for a motion to approve the minutes from January 10, 2019 with corrections, and today's agenda. Alderman Lawson motioned to approve, Alderman Hoover seconded the motion, all voted aye.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION-

-Mayor announced Scott Moore as Special Guest.

POLICE REPORT-

-Chief Kerns gave the report on police activity for January 2019.

COURT REPORT-

-A. Moore presented the January 2019 court report, with \$9,370.00 in total revenue and 66 cases disposed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS AND ALDERMEN'S REMARKS

- Alderman Lawson inquired about the green neon flags being placed within the City limits. Mayor explained the flags were from the gas company doing utility work. Mayor reminded that anyone can call Missouri One Call for information.
- Alderman White expressed his concern for pets that are being left out during the cold weather for extended period of time. Chief said that officers will continue to be aware of pets left outside in the cold and attempt to contact the owner.
- Alderman Hoover stated that she had been receiving complaints about abandoned vehicles in the City. Chief Kerns stated that the Ordinance Enforcement Officer will contact the owner(s).
- Mayor explained that the City did not apply for the Park grant in 2019. The recent weather has caused damage at the Park House. The kitchen sustained damage to the ceiling and floors. There will be a Park Committee meeting in January or February to discuss repairs and upcoming events.
- Mayor asked that the Alderman contemplate allowing alcohol at the park for a minimal fee. A fee amount will be discussed at a later date.
- Mayor received information from Brian Noller at the Northland Career Center that the Imeson Park Bridge was given national recognition.

FINANCIAL REPORTS-

- J. Hull gave the report on the financial documents. There are no concerns with Paybills resolution, cashflow or budget vs. actual documents. Alderman Hoover motioned to approve Paybills Resolution #02-14-19, Alderman Lawson seconded. All voted aye.

MAYOR'S REMARKS-

- Platte County Mayors met with Pat Klein and the KCI Aviation Director on February 6, 2019. Final designs are set to be presented and approved on February 26, 2019.
- Missouri Mayors met February 13, 2019 in Jefferson City to discuss legislative issues, including handguns on public transit and capping sales tax.
- The 2019 Storm Grant is due March 15, 2019. The City of Platte Woods will submit an application for Maple Lane repair.
- Lake Waukomis Mayor and Platte Woods Police Department met on February 14, 2019 to discuss the current police services agreement and the progress so far.
- Kansas City Metro Mayors meeting will be February 22, 2019 in Independence. They will discuss local issues and legislation.
- Mayor's Prayer Breakfast is schedule for February 26, 2019 at the Kansas City Convention Center.
- The Census Bureau is teaming up with MARC and looking for local Councilmembers to participate in the 2019 Census Survey.
- The phones at Platte Woods City Hall had been down in the past week but the issue is resolved and phones are back online.

OLD BUSINESS-

- Alderman Lawson shared the updates that have been made to the City website.
- Chief Kerns explained that Nixle has made some changes recently, and only send emails when there is a widespread emergency.

NEW BUSINESS-

- Minsky's Pizza has inquired about obtaining a permit for delivery of alcohol with their pizza orders. Mayor asked the Alderman to consider approval and cost of permit.
- Mayor asked the Alderman to consider a fee for liquor consumption at Imeson Park for private events.
- New business application -KC Music, LLC. Mark Ballard, Owner, presented his signage proposal for approval, which included a banner advertising enrollment. Mayor asked for a motion to approve business license and signage for KC Music, LLC. Alderman Cory motioned to approve, Alderman Hoover seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motioned passed.
- Right-of-Way permit – Alpha Custom Builders install of fiber optic within the city. Letter and contract attached to permit applications. Installation to begin end of March or early April depending on approval. Mayor asked for a motion to approve permit for fiber optic installation. Alderman White motioned to approve, Alderman Cory seconded the motion. All voted aye. Motioned passed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS-

ADJOURNMENT- Mayor asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alderman Hoover motioned to adjourn meeting, Alderman White seconded, all voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 8:42 pm. The next meeting will be held on March 14, 2019 at 7:00pm.
