**OPENING-** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Smedley at 7:00pm. Smedley asked the Council to review their copies of the July 11, 2018 meeting minutes and today's agenda. Mayor asked for a motion to approve the minutes from July 11, 2018, and agenda. Alderman Lawson motioned to approve, Alderman Hoover seconded the motion, all voted aye.

-Officer Noon gave the report on police activity for July 2018.

## **COMMITTEE REPORTS AND ALDERMEN'S REMARKS**

-Alderman White asked about the process for building permits and how new home owners are informed of the process of applying for a permit.

-Alderman Lawson shared a few of the HOA events coming up for the remainder of the year. She also asked about consuming alcohol at the park during events. Mayor informed that there is a process in place for alcohol consumption and it must be approved by the Chief of Police.

-Alderman Lawson stated that a resident had contacted her about solicitors going door to door. Mayor explained that only non-for-profit and religious entities are allowed to go door to door.

-Alderman Lawson informed that the City website is now live and available to the public.

Alderman Hoover had suggestions for the website and will review with Alderman Lawson.

- Mayor requested volunteers for help around the City and Imeson Park
- Officer Noon attended Emergency Management Training in accordance with the National Weather Service in July. The Police Department is moving forward with the next level of Emergency Management Training.

### **FINANCIAL REPORTS-**

- B. Huke gave the report on the financial documents. There are no concerns with Paybills resolution, cashflow or budget vs. actual documents. Alderman Hoover motioned to approve Paybills Resolution #08-08-18, Alderman Cory seconded. All voted aye.

### **MAYOR'S REMARKS-**

- Mayor gave an update about prevailing wage
- Mayor stated that the Governor was in town to discuss transportation ideas for Missouri
- Mayors next meeting is scheduled for September 5, 2018

### **OLD BUSINESS-**

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Ordinance #849 read twice by A. Moore. Mayor asked for a motion to approve Ordinance #849. Alderman Cory motioned to approve, Alderman White seconded the motion. Roll call: Cory-Aye, Hoover-Aye, Lawson-Aye, White-Aye, motion passed.
- Mayor explained that Platte Woods Police department will support the City of Lake of Waukomis Police Department. There is currently no Chief of Police for Lake Waukomis. The City of Platte Woods will receive compensation from the City of Lake Waukomis for the extra duties performed. The patrol time will increase by 20 minutes, however no additional equipment or supplies will be required. Mayor stated he will keep the council members informed of any changes.
- A. Moore, City Clerk open and reviewed the bids for asphalt repair. Mayor asked for a motion to approve \$18,500.00 for city road repair by Calvert Construction and \$3,000.00 for repairs at park by Dudley Constructions. Alderman Cory motioned to approve, Alderman Lawson seconded the motion, motioned passed. Construction is to start immediately.

### **-2019 Tax Levy and Budget Revision**

- Mayor announced this will serve as the official public hearing for the levy setting rate at 8:10pm. Alderman and Mayor discussed property tax rates/budget to be set by the City of Platte Woods for 2018-2019. Mayor informed the levy rate is set at .7427 and is reflected on the updated 2018-2019 approved budget. Alderman Hoover motioned to approve the Tax Levy for 2018, Alderman Cory seconded. All voted aye.
- Mayor officially closed the public hearing at 8:16 pm. Final budget approved as submitted.

**ADJOURNMENT-** Mayor asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alderman White motioned to adjourn meeting, Alderman Lawson seconded, all voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 8:20pm. The next meeting will be held on October 10, 2018 at 7:00pm.
