Community members:

OPENING- The meeting was called to order by Mayor Smedley at 7:00 pm. Smedley asked the Council to review their copies of the October 8, 2020 meeting minutes and today's agenda. Copies of the agenda provided to all attendees. Mayor asked for a motion to approve the minutes from October 8, 2020 and today's agenda. Alderman Hoover motioned to approve, Alderman Cory seconded the motion, all voted aye.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION-

-Joe Jones from Famous Barber requested the council to approve signage for the business. Mr. Jones presented pictures of the signage to the Alderman.

POLICE REPORT-

-Alderman Cory reported on October 2020 police activity. Copies of police activity given to Aldermen.

COURT REPORT-

-A. Moore presented the October 2020 court report, with \$5,104.00 in total revenue and 48 cases disposed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS AND ALDERMEN'S REMARKS

-Alderman Hoover stated that she made contact with the new neighbors on both sides of her residence. Alderman Hoover commented that both families are a great addition to Platte Woods.

-Alderman White inquired about the turn lane on 72nd. He expressed safety concerns with the layout of the street. Mayor explained that the City of Kansas City is responsible for designating the bike lane on 72nd Street.

-Alderman Lawson shared that Platte Woods Alderman team fixed the Platte Woods ordinance sign. Alderman Lawson also indicated that WCA Trash Service did not pick up trash the week of Veterans Day. She explained that Veterans Day was not acknowledged as a holiday on the WCA Trash website, and should not have affected trash service.

-Alderman Lawson and Alderman Hoover offered to assist in assembling the new resident welcome packets.

-Mayor shared on behalf of the Park Committee. He explained that a community service worker had been volunteering at the Park House and was able to complete a number of jobs.

FINANCIAL REPORTS-

-Alderman Hoover gave the report on the city's financial documents. Alderman Hoover stated there are no concerns with Paybills resolution, cashflow or budget vs. actual documents.

Alderman White motioned to approve Paybills Resolution #11-12-20, Alderman Lawson seconded, and all voted aye.
