OPENING- The meeting was called to order by Mayor Smedley at 7:05 pm. Smedley asked the Council to review their copies of the September 10, 2020 meeting minutes and today's agenda. Copies of the agenda provided to all attendees. Mayor asked for a motion to approve the minutes from September 10, 2020 and today's agenda. Alderman Lawson motioned to approve, Alderman Cory seconded the motion, all voted aye.

POLICE REPORT-

-Chief Kerns reported on September 2020 police activity. Copies of police activity given to Alderman.

COURT REPORT-

-E. Nielson presented the September 2020 court report, with \$2,325.00 in total revenue and 40 cases disposed of.

-Alderman Lawson inquired about the tress at 7401-7409 Woody Creek. Chief Kerns said that Platte Woods is not responsible. Alderman Lawson added that the house on Tomahawk is in need of upkeep.

FINANCIAL REPORTS-

-Alderman Hoover gave the report on the city's financial documents. Alderman Hoover stated there are no concerns with Paybills resolution, cashflow or budget vs. actual documents. Alderman Cory motioned to approve Paybills Resolution #10-08-20, Alderman Hoover seconded, and all voted aye.

MAYOR'S REMARKS-

-Street updates- MODOT is working on Valley & Roanridge, waiting until 72nd street is to be done end of month.

-City hall hours for Thursdays 8am-2pm

- Kansas City Water main replacement project will be done in 9 places in the city. Work will continue for 60 days.

-5G utility box installation from ATT was given a 90 days extension, this will give additional revenue from cell phone tower.

-Storm water will tap into system waiting for written confirmation, then will receive contracts.

-Mayor thanked Alderman Lawson and Alderman White for their help on the stop sign.

NEW BUSINESS-

-Mayor asked for a motion to approve the WCA Trash Service Contract for 2020-2021, POD Save the Children, and Woulfe Music Renewal. Alderman Hoover motioned to approve, Alderman Cory seconded the motion. All voted aye.
