OPENING- The meeting was called to order by Mayor Smedley at 7:00pm. Smedley asked the Council to review their copies of the April 11, 2018 meeting minutes and today's agenda with amendment to old business, City website update. Mayor asked for a motion to approve the minutes from April 11, 2018 and agenda. Alderman Hoover motioned to approve, Alderman Hazlett seconded the motion, all voted aye.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION-

POLICE REPORT-

-Officer Noon gave the report on police activity for April 2018.

COURT REPORT-

-A. Moore presented the April 2018 court report, with \$4,850.00 in total revenue and 33 cases disposed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS AND ALDERMEN'S REMARKS

-Alderman Hazlett has enjoyed his time serving the City of Platte Woods, he appreciates recognition from the City for his years of service.

-Mayor shared that Imeson Park has a number of booked events coming up this month. There has been an increase in residents visiting the park during the warmer weather, the feedback has been positive. The Park Committee will meet soon to discuss moving forward with improvements.

FINANCIAL REPORTS-

-B. Huke gave the report on the financial documents. There are no concerns with Paybills resolution, cashflow or budget vs. actual documents. Alderman Lawson motioned to approve Paybills Resolution #05-09-18, Alderman Hazlett seconded. All voted aye.

MAYOR'S REMARKS-

-Mayor stated that he was in Jefferson City on May 7, 2018. There are currently 65 bills on the table for discussion. There will be continuing discussion on 911 cell towers, wage reform, SB5 and SB572. At this time there is no predicted changes to be made to SB5 and SB572. Mayor shared that a highlighted discussion in relation to building permits and the limited timeframe to approve them within municipalities will take place next month.

-Mayor indicated there were inquiries about additional signage on Prairie View for the new businesses opening up in Platte Woods. Mayor researched that the City ordinance does not conflict with addition signage, however, the rental company is responsible for maintaining the sign within City guidelines.

OLD BUSINESS-

-Alderman Lawson gave an update on the City website upgrade. Josh Everett from Maple Woods Community College will be working with the City. Alderman Lawson gave handouts with template examples. Website should be completed by the end of June. A copy of the proposal is included with the council packet.

-Mayor asked for a motion to approve hiring Josh Everett, not to exceed \$400, for City website update. Alderman Hazlett motioned to approve, Alderman Hoover seconded the motion. All voted aye.
